The AECE society of Electronics and Communication Engineering Department organised a guest lecture on "How to memorise faster and retain it for longer duration" for second, third, and fourth year B.Tech students on December 7, 2023.Academic Dean and Head of Department (ECE), Prof. R.K. Yadav, addressed a welcome and began the programme at 3:00 p.m. This programme was attended by nearly 100 students as well as faculty from the ECE Department.

The speaker was Mr. Jitendra Tiwari from Made Easy, an educationalist whose name is registered in the LIMCA BOOK OF RECORDS for memorizing the world's toughest dictionary. He used brief videos and pictures of words with meanings to illustrate his learning methods during his lecture. He gets the students attention at the beginning of the lecture by asking them their phone number's last two digits, the last two digits of which he types into the system. He then displays the string created by those numbers on the screen and gives them five minutes to learn it. He asked students whether anyone has been able to learn the string after five minutes. Next, he proves his ability to memorise. While typing, he learned every number. Then he talked about learning laws and ways to retain it for longer. Following that, he talked about a few aspects one should look ahead after graduating and earning a BTech degree.

The lecture was informative, with a small number of students engaging with the speaker and asking questions the speaker also discussed the advantages, methods and aspect of this in the future, and he motivated our students to learn more by imparting knowledge.
