

4. What changes would you make so the rich stop getting richer and poor stop getting poorer of you had the control?

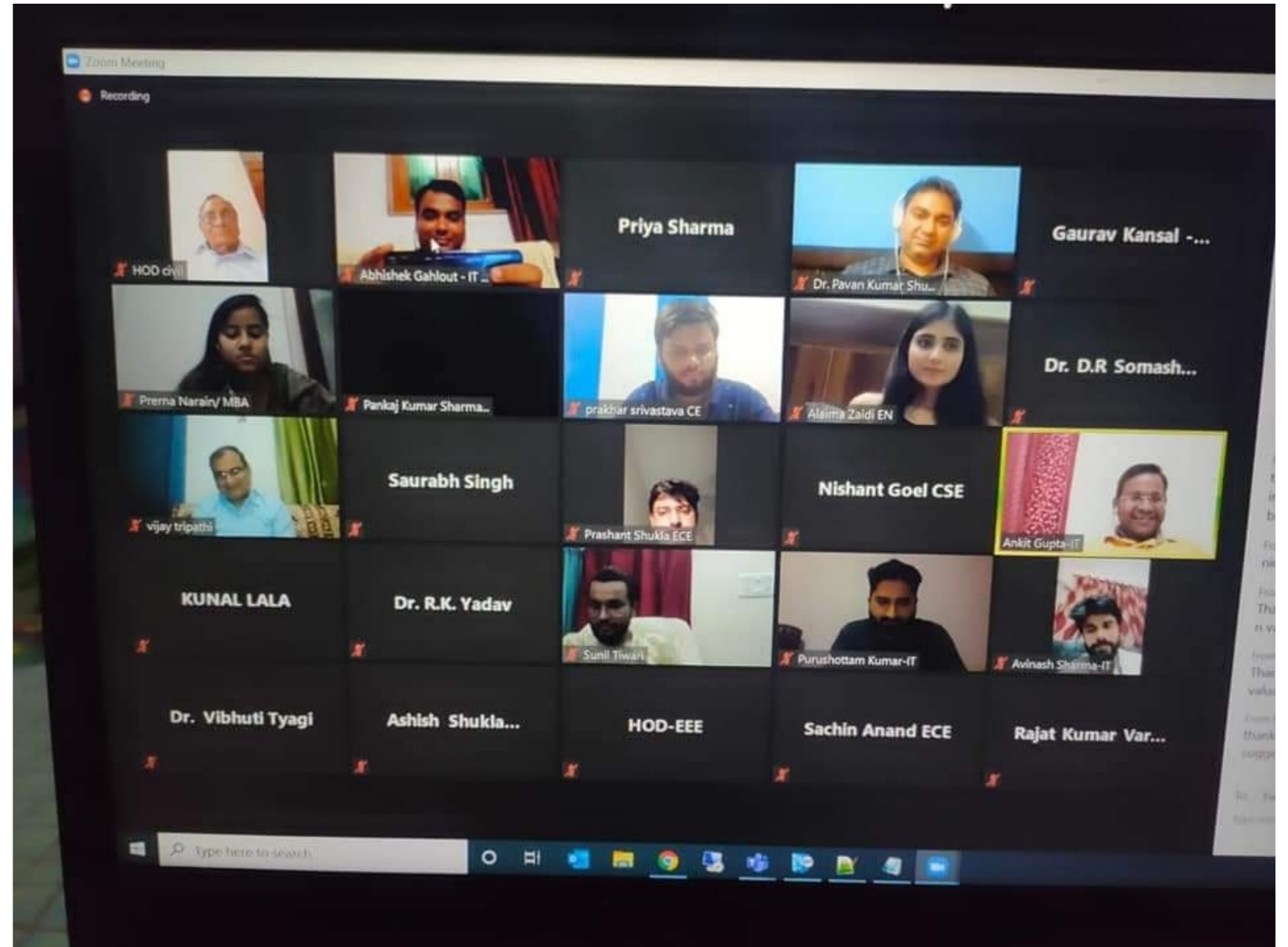
Obviously, an event without winners is incomplete. So, here we have the talented students who performed really well in this event.

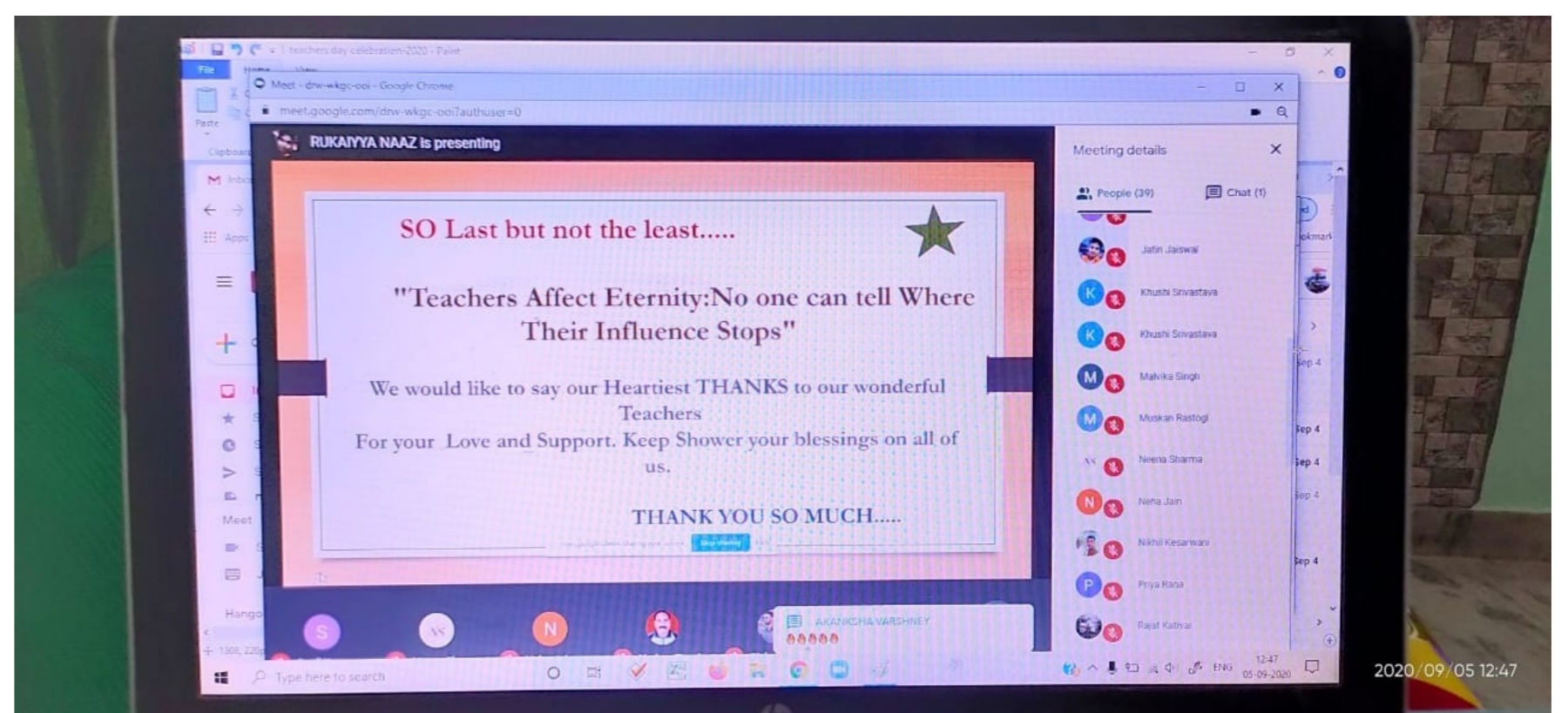
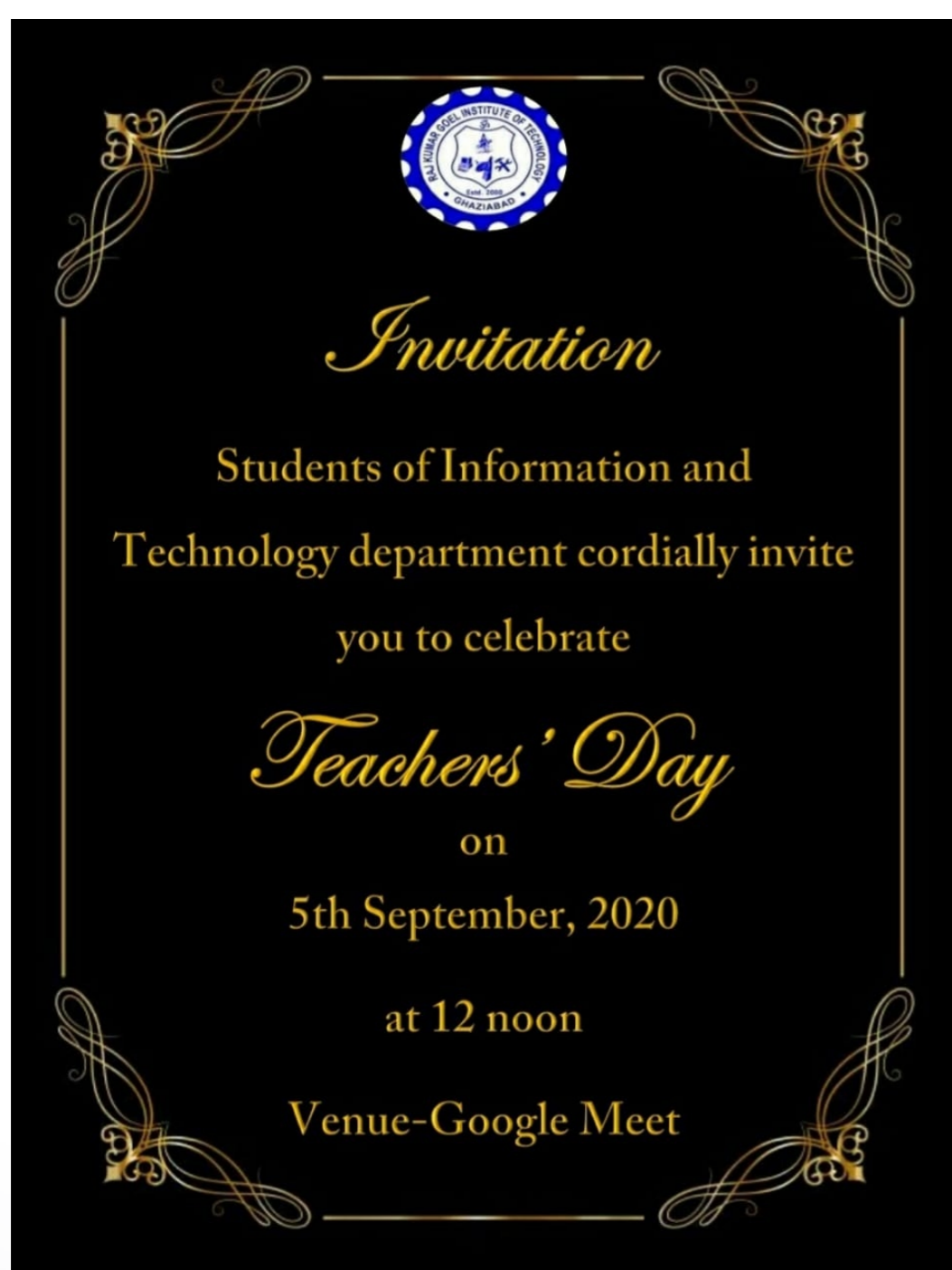


Teachers' Day Celebration

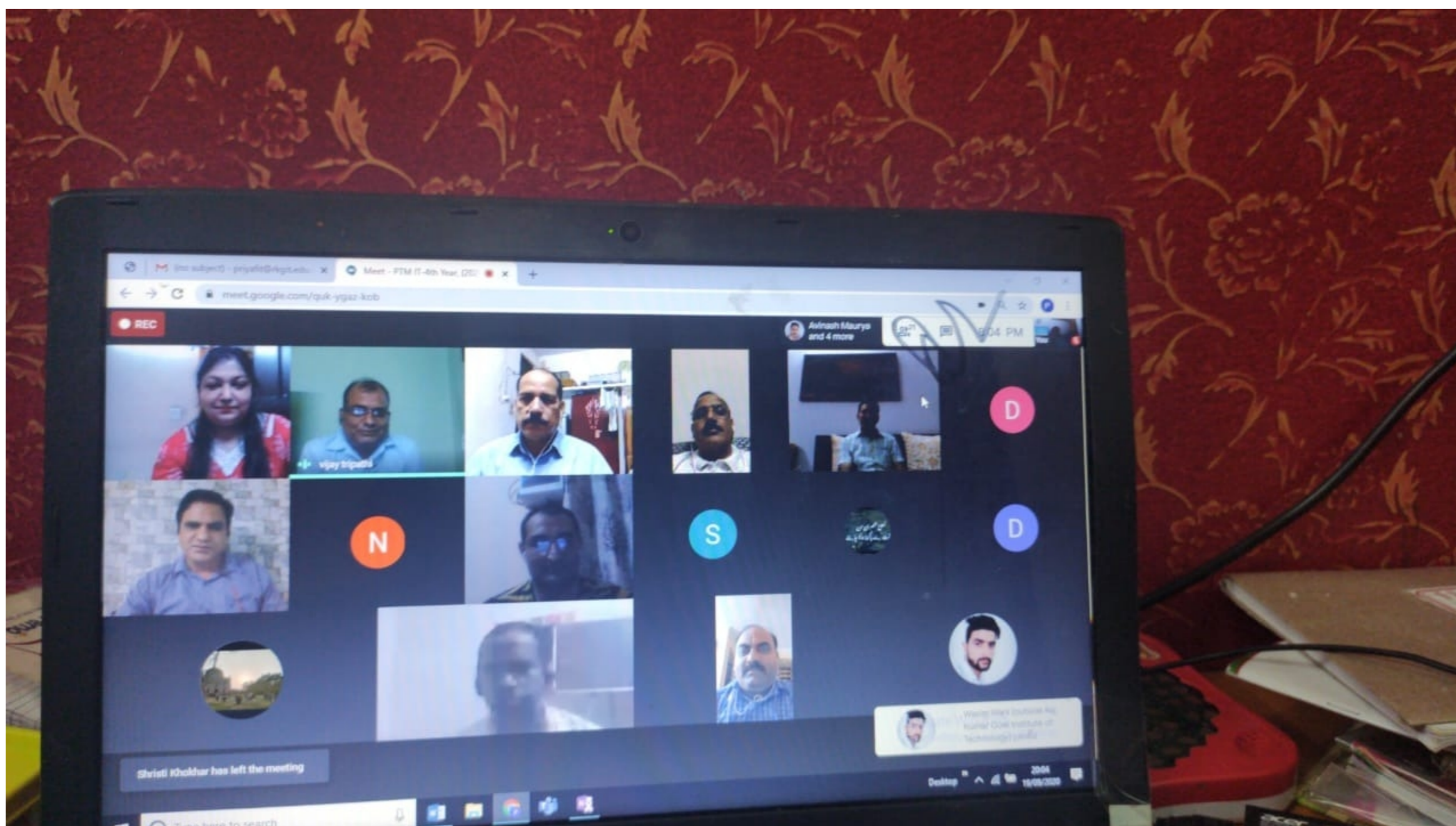
