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






Guest Lecture - "Financial Empowerment through Wealth creation"


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Super Investor-Mock Stock Trading Challenge

Faculty Corner

Why Would Anyone Follow You?

Why would you want to lead anyone? Anyone who wants to lead others should be humbled by this question, at least for a minute. Leaders require followers, and following is a choice.

Why Should Anyone Be Led by You? is a 10-page essay. Based on considerable studies, the book by Robert Goffee and Gareth Jones finds four surprising characteristics that inspirational leaders possess. Although you could succeed in a leadership role without these traits, few people would want to follow you if you don't have them, according to the writers. Their four main points are outlined as follows: **1.** Only disclose a few of your weaknesses

A leader can establish a connection by deliberately displaying a flaw (such as being cranky on Mondays, being a little unorganized, etc.) to show that he is human and fallible, just like you. This increases authenticity and trust. Additionally, it shows people that you, as a leader, are not able to handle everything on your own. It's crucial to use caution and discrimination while revealing your frailties. Don't expose a deadly weakness.

2. Develop your senses

Effective inspirational leaders are skilled at gathering and analysing "soft data" gleaned through interpersonal encounters. They may more quickly spot potential conflicts before they spiral out of control and converse on delicate subjects with more clarity and elegance by learning to interpret what isn't being spoken. The authors caution that it is crucial to examine your impressions with the help of a dependable friend who can serve as a counsellor and by getting input from people you lead.

3. Develop a Firm Empathy

Motivating managers treat their staff with a concept known as tough empathy. They have a strong sense of empathy for their colleagues and the work they undertake. They provide their employees with what they require, not what they desire, at the same time.

4. Be Different, Be Brave

Motivating leaders make the most of their individuality to maintain their social isolation. They maintain a certain air of distance because they understand that leadership is not a popularity contest. The key takeaway is that to maintain and increase their influence, good leaders stand out from the crowd.

Are These Qualities Learnable?

What should leaders do with the writers' fascinating arguments if they agree with them? I believe that some people are born with certain qualities while others never will be. Can you learn them? There are clear difficulties in teaching someone to be sincere or to care about the people they lead. However, by understanding their significance, picking up methods to boost self-awareness and interpersonal skills, and developing the skills to communicate the genuine respect and passion they already have, any leader can significantly increase their leadership influence and skill. And it will do a lot to motivate the people they are in charge of.
