- Gaming and Health Tech.

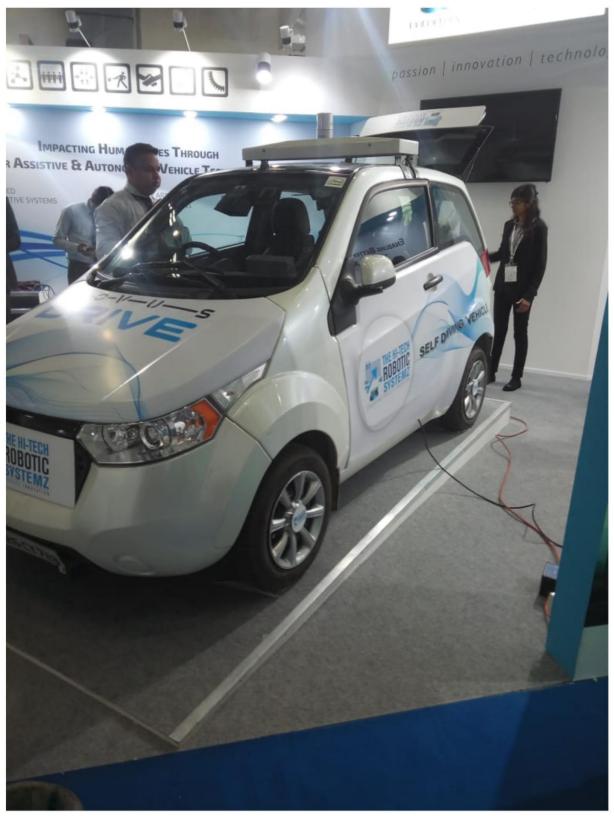
Some of the important highlights of event included:
