The protection of Intellectual Property Rights (IPR) is important for the economy and for its further growth in areas such as research, innovation and employment. Effective IPR enforcement is also essential to health and safety. The session ended with a Q&A session, giving the participants opportunity to clarify their doubts about entrepreneurship.

Director D.R. Somasheker also motivated the students with his short talk after Mr. Prashant Singh. The session was concluded with vote of thanks by Dr Puneet Chandra Srivastava, Dean, EII-RKGIT, and Ghaziabad.
