1. Welcome Note by the Chairman-IOAC

The meeting started with the warm welcome to all the members by the Chairman-IQAC Dr. D.R.Somashekar. He then requested Coordinator-IQAC Dr.Sanjeev Goyal to proceed.

Dr. Sanjeev Goyal thanked the chair and started to elaborate the agenda point wise.

2. Review of the Previous Meeting (13-07-2020)

Dr. Sanjeev Goyal (IQAC-Coordinator) told that, in the last online meeting of IQAC which was held on July 13th, 2020 during the lockdown period, discussions about the conduction and feedback of the online classes, FDPs, webinars & e-certificate courses, preparation of the soft notes and maintenance of the attendance record was held among the members. All the members expressed their satisfaction on all the above activities during the lockdown period.

3. Audit Dates (Academic Audit Odd Semeste: 2020-21)

All the HODs requested the chairman-IQAC to conduct the audit of their departments for the odd semester 2020-21 after the university's end semester examination, which was agreed upon by the chairman Dr. D.R. Somashekar. He then requested coordinator to have the audit in the second week of April, 2021.

4. Revised R & D Policy

In order to create the research ambience in the institute and motivate the research activities in the campus, the existing 'Research & Development' policy was revised and placed before the members by the coordinator, which was consented by all.

All the heads were then requested to circulate the same among the faculty members of their respective departments and ensure its implementation.

5. Service Book

In order to bring transparency in the appointment process of the employees and to maintain their service records, institute introduced the 'Service Book'. With the consent of all present, HODs were requested to get this book filled by their faculty and staff members and submit to the H.R. head of the institute.



6. Self Appraisal

In order to have the track record of individual teacher's achievements during the one calendar year, 'Self-Appraisal Record Book' was introduced. HODs were requested to get the same filled up semester wise by the faculty of their departments and submit it at the end of each semester to the Director-academics.

7. OIP-1,2,3 Forms

For giving the boost to the academic activities in the institute and to enhance the teacher's involvement, forms 1, 2 &3 related to 'Quality Improvement Programme were introduced in the beginning of the odd semester 2020-21. In the meeting HODs were requested to monitor its implementation on regular basis.

8. Mentors & Mentees

In addition to the existing system of students' grievance redressal where counselors and adopters used to take care of the group of students, the concept of 'Mentors and Mentees' was brought in among the members. A mentor/mentee will be assigned a group of students from 2nd year onward till the completion of the course, so that the track record of the student is available with the concerned student till the final year, which would certainly help to address the grievances in a better way. All the members agreed to it.

9. NSS in the Campus

The RKGIT institute has always been in the lead role, when the services on social front are talked about, whether it be free education to the children of the deprived section of the society or food to the needy or adoption of the village for the all round growth. However now it has been decided to bring all such services under the banner of 'National Social Services (NSS)' & 'Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA)' to augment the activities on the larger scale. HODs were requested to identify the volunteers from among the students and the faculty members who wish to get involved whole heartedly in such activities.



10. FDPs & Conferences in the Offline Mode

As the lockdown is almost over and the institute is back to its normalcy, the chairman-IQAC Dr. D.R. Somashekar requested all the HODs to conduct the 'Quality Improvement Programs' in the offline mode too in addition to the ongoing online mode.

Group Advisor Prof. Laxman Prasad Sir emphasized that in the IQAC meetings the quality aspect of the issues should be focused upon.

Meeting ended with vote of thanks by the Coordinator -IQAC.




